At Herbert Morrison we follow the National Curriculum. Children are taught a range of subjects throughout the year. In Harmony provide part of the music curriculum. Some children are taught off site by specialists for particular subjects, for example last term: Years 3 and 6 were taught Computing and Cricket at the Oval Cricket Ground.

If you are unsure of your child's username and password please speak to the class teacher so you don't miss out.

The website is also a useful tool for information. Please look at our school instagram account *\*hmpprimaryschool\**; this is a useful tool for discussion and reflection on what is happening in school.

Now you know your child's topic and areas of study you can talk about it with them and help them to develop their understanding. A visit of interest is highly recommended, for example: The Science Museum or the Tate Modern will support particular aspects.
